



Dear rider,

Due the ongoing COVID situation we ask you to check this website

https://infocovid.viaggiasesicuri.it/index_en.html to have all the information about corona test to enter in Italy.

Furthermore, a mask is required on the ENTIRE FACILITY. The common MEDICAL MASKS, FFP2 MASKS and everyday masks made of fabric are allowed.

- Mask compulsory on the entire facility
 - Stables, entire parking lot, catering area, training and show areas, sanitary facilities, etc. The only exception is the rider while riding.
- A minimum distance of 1.5 m must ALWAYS be observed, also when you are riding. Please ensure that enough distance is kept between both riders and horses (COVID & HERPES)
- No groupings in the entire area
- Please ensure that your hands are adequately disinfected, disinfections points are set up everywhere

PROCEDURE FOR ARRIVAL

- At the checkpoint at the entrance, control of the temperature, submission of the contact details of all persons. (Please fill in everything and bring it with you)
- Delivery of a bracelet to all riders/grooms/trainers/helpers, only people with a bracelet can stay at the venue

UNLOADING THE HORSES AT THE STABLES (INTERNATIONAL & NATIONAL COMPETITION)

- Control of all horses, passports and temperatures
 - Each Person Responsibility of the horse must take the temperature with his own thermometer under the observation of the Vet.
 - If a horse has the temperature from 36,5° until 38,5° it is accepted, you can unload equipment from the truck
 - If a horse has the temperature from 38,5° until 39,0°: horse on hold, other stables for one hour and a second temperature measurement at least 1h after the first one. Truck on hold and no unloading equipment from the truck
 - If a horse exceeds a temperature of 39,0 °C or show symptoms, the horse/horses aren't allowed to enter the stables until a PCR test is taken and results are received. Horse moved to isolation stables and also all in-contact horses.
- The Veterinarian teams collecting passport, traces and the FEI self-certification of health status for all of their horses on the event venue, including mandatory temperature monitoring charts for the 10 days leading up to the event. The Vet team enter the horse's passport on the FEI application.
- Allocation of the boxes, unloading of equipment and stabling. **Please use the box who the stable manager says!**
 - the checklist must be attached to each box, at all times accessible to our vet team/officials. The temperature of each horse is to be measured twice a day (morning before 9a.m. and evening from 5p.m. until 7p.m.) If there are any symptoms or abnormalities in the temperature course during the event, a PCR test is carried out and the horse is placed in quarantine.
- Allocation of parking space (the instruction of the stewards must always be followed!)
